Pressure Grows on Almunia Over EU Google Settlement

The European Union's antitrust chief Joaquín Almunia is facing mounting pressure to reconsider aspects of this month's settlement with Google Inc.

In recent weeks, other members of the European Commission — including Viviane Reding, Michel Barnier and Günther Oettinger — complained in closed-door meetings that Mr. Almunia announced the Google settlement without fully consulting them beforehand, EU officials said. Now, the competition chief has been asked to appear before a European Parliament committee to explain the commission's deal with the search giant.

Mr. Almunia earlier this month announced a landmark deal with Google to address concerns over its abuse of dominance in Europe, where it enjoys a market share of over 90%.

In a letter to Mr. Almunia, two lawmakers dealing with antitrust issues at the parliament said they were "unsettled" by reports of disagreement among the bloc's 28 commissioners over the settlement and by the "serious criticism from several industry stakeholders and consumers on both sides of the Atlantic."

In the letter, seen by The Wall Street Journal, Ramon Tremosa i Balcells and Andreas Schwab express particular concern that a wide group of Google rivals, companies and consumer groups won't be given the chance to respond:

We would like to reiterate our view that the only way to verify the effectiveness and impact of Google's proposals is to subject them to the kind of expert scrutiny that previously accurately helped revealing the weaknesses of the proposed sets of commitments.

Mr. Almunia has said he doesn't see the need for a third round of consultation but will seek feedback from the 16 formal complainants in the case, who include Microsoft Corp. That decision sparked uproar from numerous rivals and consumer groups, who insisted they must have a say as the settlement was hardly better than two earlier proposals by Google. Some even said the new offer was worse than the
